From the mountains of Asia to the plains of Africa, from the forests of Europe to the vast spaces of the Americas, each bird you will encounter is connected to a territory, a story, and a way of life. Some live on a single continent, while others traverse the globe, reminding us that for them, borders do not exist.

Throughout this journey, you will discover how these birds of prey, so different yet so similar, share the same essential role in maintaining nature's balance.

Because they are living beings, guided by their instincts and the weather, some birds may choose not to appear, making each performance a unique and unpredictable moment.

ASIA



FALCON

Speed

Streamlined for extreme speed, they are the sprinters of the sky.



ROCK EAGLE-OWL

Enigmatic

A «cousin» of the Eurasian Eagle Owl, but smaller and lighter in color.



TAWNY EAGLE

High-flying

The pirate of the skies: Very brave, it does not hesitate to steal prey from others or feed on the ground.



EASTERN IMPERIAL EAGLE

Majestic

A majestic eagle with sharp vision to spot prey from great heights.



STELLER'S SEA EAGLE

Powerful

A force of nature: A massive yellow beak capable of tearing apart even frozen prey.

AKTIONEN IN DER SHOW :

Accelerations and precise dives to catch a fake prey (lure exercise)

Wide flight and response to the keepers' calls.

Depending on weather conditions, it can soar high using ascending currents

Gains altitude before diving towards the keeper's glove, mimicking a hunting action.

Demonstration of its powerful flight and impressive stature (2.50m wingspan).

AFRICA



BATELEUR Tightrope walker

Tightrope walker: Almost tailless, it balances by tilting from one wing to the other.



SECRETARYBIRD Unusual

Quick strike: Its long legs act like hammers to neutralize prey.



AFRICAN FISH EAGLE Accuracy

The Voice of Africa: Famous for its clear cry that resonates over African lakes.



VULTURE Cleaner

They protect nature from epidemics by eliminating carcasses.

AMERICA



ANDEAN CONDOR Proximity

Harmless giant: 3.20m wingspan, but feet incapable of grasping.



STRIATED CARACARA Curious

The little pirate: clever and bold, it fears nothing and loves to steal.



TURKEY VULTURE Ambivalent

Found in all types of environments: from mountains to seas and jungles.



BUSE DE HARRIS Social

Pack spirit: A complex family structure led by a dominant pair, where each bird has a specific role.

AKTIONEN IN DER SHOW :

Flying very close to the audience.

The Secretary Bird's dance: Demonstration of ground strikes on a target.

Quick fishing action in the central pool.

Collective flight close to the audience's heads: duck down!

Ground roaming, directly interacting with spectators.

Slipping between your legs to explore every corner of its environment.

Sliding back to the keepers' calls.

Coordinated landings on the gloved hands of the audience.



SPECTACLED OWL **Fun**

Despite its size, it is a very powerful bird, capable of capturing small monkeys like squirrel monkeys when the opportunity arises.



BALD EAGLE **Majestic**

USA emblem: The bird featured on American coats of arms.



SNOWY OWL **Mystic**

Snow radar: Capable of hearing a rodent moving under 40 cm of snow.

EUROPE



GREAT GRAY OWL **Silent**

Facial radar: Its immense disc captures the slightest sound.



WESTERN BARN OWL **Endearing**

Its heart-shaped facial disc channels sounds to its ears, allowing it to hunt in darkness.



WHITE-TAILED SEA-EAGLE **Majestic**

The largest eagle in Europe.



BLACK KITE **Agile**

The agile opportunist: Its tail acts as a rudder for quick and precise turns.



EGYPTIAN VULTURE **Intelligent**

The little genius: Capable of using a stone as a tool to break eggs.



EURASIAN EAGLE-OWL **Enigmatic**

The largest nocturnal bird of prey in the world, with remarkable hunting power.

AKTIONEN IN DER SHOW :

Flying over the flight area, demonstrating rapid wing beats.

Quick fishing action in the central pool.

Stealthy approach close to the ground.

Silent flights: a discreet flight crossing the area in silence.

Perfectly silent flight.

Quick fishing action in the central pool.

Feeding in mid-air without ever touching the ground.

Attempts to break a plaster ostrich egg before your eyes.

Sliding back to the keepers' calls.
